ENTRIES/ACCEPTANCES

Entry fee €20 (£20) for the parade lap. Postal orders, cheques or bank drafts only – NO CASH, and made payable to Loughshinny Motorcycle Supporters Club. Post dated or third party cheques cannot be accepted. This money will be used in the prize fund for the main event.

Closing date for entries is Friday 20th May 2016 – which will allow for information to be included in our race programme.

If more than the required number of entries are received a list of reserves will be selected and will be listed as reserves and not in numerical order. If reserves are needed they will be placed in order of practice times. Riders will be notified of acceptance or otherwise as soon as possible. Riders must hold a current licence endorsed for road racing, issued by the M.C.U.I, M.C.I., A.C.U. or S.A.C.U. EU licence with authorisation from the issuing centre.

EVENT DETAILS

Competitors will be led from the paddock to the start and finish where they will form up and then be led in a controlled manner for two laps around the circuit and back to the start and finish.

FLAG SIGNALS

Length of course 2.9 miles. All flag [IF REQUIRED] signals on left hand side at Start/Finish. Flag signals will be strictly adhered to, any rider not obeying flag signals will be dealt with under the G.C.R.'s of the MCUI.

SCRUTINY

The onus is on the competitor to be in the paddock before 9am Saturday 2nd July. Scrutiny on these bikes will open at 11:30am and will finish at 12pm sharp. Sign-on etc will be conducted just after the machine has been scrutineered. Competitors who will be using a competition bike which is being used in the main event will not need to have this bike re-scrutineered but will need to come to sign-on at 11:30am

STOPPING ON COURSE DURING THE RACE

A competitor who breaks down during the parade lap place his machine on the side of the course in such a position as not to cause any hazard or danger to other competitors. A rider recovery vehicle will be provided between designated races.

MACHINERY

Only racing machines will be accepted. The sump bung and oil filter need to be lock wired.

COMPETITOR PARKING

Competitor's may only park in the paddock area.

DRINK & DRUGS

All competitors may be breathalysed prior to taking part in this classic lap.

HELMETS & PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

Helmets as per F.I.M. Rules of the M.C.U.I.

LICENCE

Participants must have a parade lap licence as a minimum, this can be applied from Motorcycling Ireland
